Changi Airport Sees 7.2% More Passenger Traffic In The First Half of 2005

Changi Airport saw a total of 15.44 million passengers passing through the airport in the first six months of 2005. This represents an increase of 7.2% over the same period last year.

Last month, Changi Airport handled 2.81 million passengers, which is 7.8% more than in June 2004. This was the highest monthly traffic recorded for 2005, and could be attributed to more people travelling during the month-long school vacation in Singapore.

Air cargo throughput reached 869,700 tonnes in the first half of 2005, or 1.6% growth over the corresponding period in 2004. Changi Airport processed 149,800 tonnes of cargo in June 2005, 0.1% higher than last year.

Changi Airport is currently served by 81 airlines connecting to over 175 cities in 56 countries, with more than 3,900 weekly flights.
