Changi Airport's Passenger Traffic Grows by 8.7% Year-On-Year

2.65 million passengers passed through Changi Airport in September 2005, an increase of 8.7% over the same month last year. Between January and September 2005, Changi Airport received 23.8 million passengers, representing a 7.5% climb over the corresponding period last year.

The demand for air travel increased during the weekends before as well as after the school holidays between 5 and 10 September 2005.

Meanwhile, Changi Airport handled 160 thousand tonnes of airfreight in September 2005, a rise of 2.8% compared to September 2004. As a whole, Changi Airport handled 1.34 million tonnes of air cargo between January and September 2005 or 2% higher than the same period last year.

Changi Airport is currently served by 81 airlines connecting to 181 cities in 56 countries, with more than 3,900 weekly flights.
