Singapore Changi Airport Nets Four Best Awards in Five days

Changi Airport tops the chart again in recent airport surveys conducted by three international travel magazines.

Readers of popular UK travel magazine, Condé Nast Traveller, bestowed upon Changi Airport the 'World's Best Airport' award for the fifth year. Changi scored above 90 marks for efficiency of check-in/transfers, cleanliness, design/layout, safety/security, luggage handling, flight information/clarity of signs, lounge facilities, as well as shopping/duty-free facilities. It achieved the highest overall score ahead of Hong Kong and Dubai airports.

In another reader survey, conducted by Travel Savvy magazine, Changi secured 54% of the votes and edged out airports in Dubai, Hong Kong and Munich. This is the second consecutive year that Changi has won 'Best Airport in the World' award given by the bi-monthly business and leisure travel magazine, which is distributed to some 135,000 readers in the US and Canada.

Closer home, the Asia Pacific edition of Business Traveller magazine gave away not one, but two awards to Changi Airport - 'Best Airport in the World' and 'Best Airport Duty-Free in the World'. This is the 14th and 8th consecutive years that Asian travellers have cast their votes in Changi's favour.

Including these four new awards, Changi Airport has won a total of 12 awards so far for the year 2005.
