Changi Airport Registers Steady Traffic Growth in August

Passenger and airfreight movements continue to climb

Singapore Changi Airport continued to enjoy steady traffic growth in August. Almost 2.96 million passengers passed through Changi in August, a 6.4% increase over the same period last year.

In the first 8 months of this year, more than 22.8 million passenger movements have been registered at Changi Airport. This is an 8.2% increase compared to 2005. The growth puts Changi on track to surpass last year's record passenger movements of 32.4 million.

On the cargo front, Changi processed almost 157,100 tonnes, with freight throughput growing by 3.1%. This brings the total freight handled so far this year to more than 1.24 million tonnes, a 5.8 percent climb over 2005.

As at 1 September 2006, Changi is served by 82 airlines with more than 4,000 weekly flights to 184 cities in 57 countries.
