## **Incubus Meets Travellers at Changi Airport**

Fans of Alternative Band Incubus got a rare chance to interact with their favourite band when they arrived at Singapore Changi Airport this evening. Incubus is in Singapore for a concert at Fort Canning Park.

The American band spontaneously posed for photographs and interacted with travellers at Terminal 2's Departure / Transit Mall. The five-piece band comprises vocalist Brandon Boyd, lead guitarist Michael Einziger, bassist Ben Kenney, drummer Jose Pasillas and Chris Kilmore on the turntables and keyboards. Best known for hit singles *Megalomaniac*, *Wish You Were Here* and *Anna Molly*, Incubus has had multi-platinum sales with albums such as *Light Grenades* and *Morning View*.

This rare opportunity to catch Incubus in-person was made possible by the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) and Changi Airport's meet-and-greet sessions with famous personalities. Previous celebrity sessions featured Jay Chou, Backstreet Boys, Bollywood superstars such as Shah Rukh Khan, Amitabh Bachchan and Sanjay Dutt, and top golfer Annika Sorenstam. Changi Airport is the first airport in the world to organise such meet-and-greet sessions for travellers in transit.
