Taiwanese Band F.I.R. Makes Special Appearance at Changi Airport

Lucky passengers walked away with giant posters autographed by popular Taiwanese band F.I.R. while others had the rare opportunity to take photographs with the band. This was made possible as F.I.R. made a special appearance at Singapore Changi Airport today. The band, which is touring Asia ahead of their upcoming concerts, also took part in a question-and-answer session during the meet-and-greet at Terminal 1's Departure / Transit Mall.

F.I.R. is a pop band formed by renowned producer Ian Chen. It comprises lead female vocalist Faye Zhan and guitarist Real Huang. The band caught the attention of Asian audiences in 2004 with their hit *Lydia*, the theme song for the Taiwanese idol drama *The Outsiders*.

This rare opportunity to catch F.I.R. in-person was made possible by the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore and Changi Airport's meet-and-greet sessions with famous personalities.
